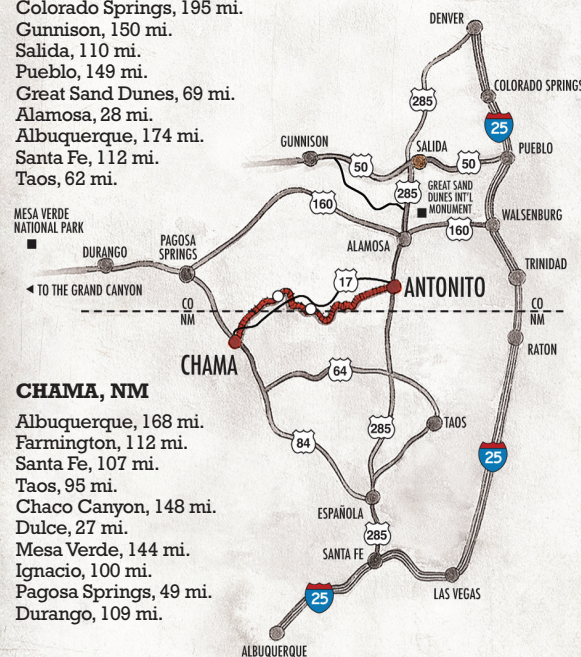

## EXPERIENCE THE AUTHENTIC WEST

**Built in 1880**, the Cumbres and Toltec Scenic Railroad was part of the Denver and Rio Grande extension into the silver-rich San Juan Mountains near Silverton, Colorado.

Service on this portion of the line was discontinued in 1969 but the railroad, including its equipment and buildings, was saved by the states of New Mexico and Colorado.

Designated a National Historic Landmark in 2012, it is the longest, highest, and most complete example of late nineteenth and early twentieth century narrow gauge railroading in the nation.

Climb aboard to experience 64 miles of WOW!

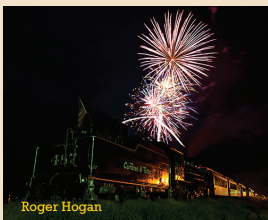


### CUMBRES SUNSET DINNER TRAIN

Join Cinder Bear for a fun filled trip to Cumbres Pass and back that is designed just for the kids. Lunch is provided in our event tent upon returning to Chama.



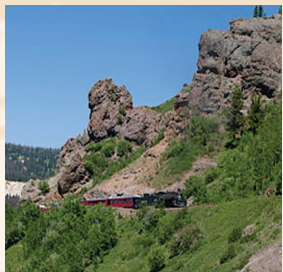
### 4TH OF JULY CELEBRATION TRAIN

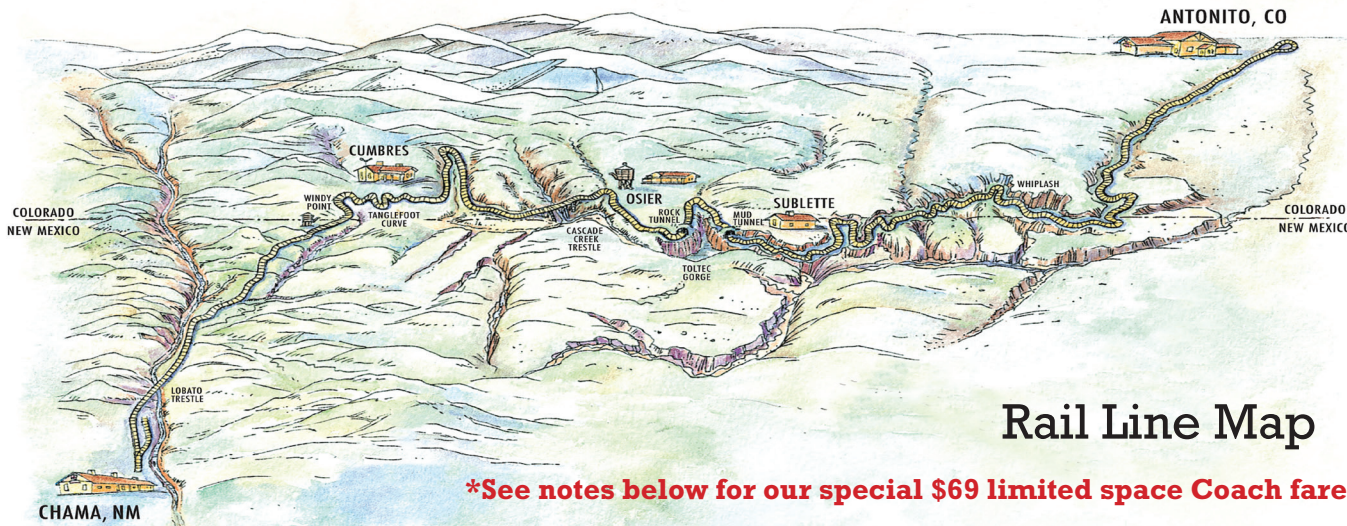


### OPEN AIR GONDOLA
